To Ellis County Commissioners Court,

I, Elizabeth Penny, permit Ellis County R&B 1 to remove brush, trees and barbed wire fencing along Wilson Rd. to make room for a permanent drainage ditch. The ditch will improve drainage along the roadway and help preserve the resurfacing of Wilson Rd. benefiting the residents and tax payers of Ellis County.

Ellis County R&B 1 agrees to put in place temporary barbed wire fencing until construction of Wilson Rd. is complete. During construction waste material may be placed on my property, however, Ellis County R&B 1 will remove or safely dispose of material in place.

On or before October 31st 2015 Ellis County R&B 1 will replace temporary fencing with permanent 4 strand barbed wire fence with metal T post and anchor post as needed in a location that allows Ellis County to maintain the drainage ditch as a public improvement. Once I accept the permanent fence Ellis County and Ellis County R&B 1 will have no further duty regarding the fence.
