



SHORT TITLE:

Road frontage variance for Parcel ID No. 179593 on Andrea Road.

LEGAL CAPTION:

Consider & act upon a request to grant a one-time variance for Parcel ID No. 179593 from Section IV (B)(2) (Residential Lots) of the Subdivision Development Standards to allow one (1) lot without meeting the minimum public road frontage. The property contains ± 1.124 acres of land on the west side of Andrea Road, ± 305 feet south of Shannon Court in the ETJ of the City of Waxahachie, Road & Bridge Precinct No. 4.



APPLICANT(S):

John and Trina Harkins



PURPOSE:

The applicant wishes to plat his property for future residential use. However, before applying for a plat, a variance is required. The proposed lot will not meet the minimum public road frontage requirement of 150 feet as the applicant’s property has ± 56 feet and falls ± 94 feet short of the public road frontage requirement.



HISTORY:

There is no previous subdivision history associated with this property. A portion of Andrea Road is public and maintained by the County, but another portion is considered private. The legal description on the deed of the adjacent property owner shows a large portion of Andrea Road to be within the boundaries of their property and therefore private, however, no record of official road abandonment request or official Court Order has been found indicating where and when Andrea Road became private. The latest road list adopted by the Court in 2005 showed Andrea Road as a public street but did not mention an exact road length. Subsequent road reports state Andrea Road is public for about 300 feet. The applicant acknowledges that a portion of Andrea Road has been inaccessible past a certain point for two (2) decades.



OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION:

Section VIII (B) outlines the criteria below for granting relief from the rules and regulations.

1. *That there are special circumstances or conditions affecting the land involved such that the strict application of the provisions of this Order would deprive the applicant of the reasonable use of his land; and,*
2. *That the relief is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right of the applicant; and,*



3. *That the granting of the relief will not be detrimental to the public finances, health, safety or welfare, or injurious to other property in the area; and,*
4. *That the granting of the relief will not have the effect of preventing the orderly subdivision of other land in the area in accordance with the provisions of the Order.*
5. *That the situation causing the hardship or difficulty is neither self-imposed or self-created.*

Section VIII (A) (1) (i) requires notice to be sent to property owners within 200 feet of the property with the requested variance at least fifteen (15) days before the meeting date. Staff sent out seven (7) notices via regular mail on March 11, 2019 to satisfy this requirement.



ANALYSIS:

Although the applicant has the minimum 150 feet road frontage required, only a portion of Andrea Road is considered a public road. The length of the public portion of the road does not extend to the entire front of his property, thereby meeting the criteria for granting a variance. Due to the lack of clarity of whether this road is public or private and the applicant having only has public road access of ± 56 feet, staff supports this variance request.



RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends **approval** of this variance to Section IV (B) (2) (Lots) of the Subdivision & Development Standards, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) An application for a simplified shall be submitted for review that closely mirrors Exhibit B in the attached order.

AND AMONG OTHER PROCEEDINGS, THE FOLLOWING ORDER WAS PASSED AS FOLLOWS:

AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS’ COURT OF ELLIS COUNTY, TEXAS GRANTING A ONE-TIME VARIANCE FROM SECTION IV (B) (2) (LOTS) OF THE SUBDIVISION & DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS, TO ALLOW ONE (1) LOT WITHOUT MEETING THE MINIMUM ROAD FRONTAGE REQUIREMENT. THE PROPERTY CONTAINS ± 1.124 ACRES OF LAND AT PARCEL ID NO. 17959 LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF ANDREA ROAD, ± 305 FEET SOUTH OF SHANNON COURT IN THE ETJ OF THE CITY OF WAXAHACHIE, ROAD & BRIDGE PRECINCT NO. 4, WITH PROPERTY MORE FULLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT “B”, PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners’ Court of Ellis County, Texas, in compliance with the laws of the State of Texas and the orders of Ellis County, Texas, have given the requisite notices and otherwise, and after holding and affording a full and fair hearing to all interested persons, and in the exercise of its legislative discretion, have concluded that this proposal should be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS’ COURT OF ELLIS COUNTY TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. GRANTING OF A VARIANCE.

The Commissioners’ Court finds that the variance criteria outlined in Section VIII (B) of the Subdivision & Development Standards apply and are set forth above are incorporated into the body of this order as if fully set forth herein and the granting of relief in the form of a lesser standard will not impact adversely



on public health, safety, general welfare, traffic conditions, and not alter the nature, character, and quality of the subdivision.

SECTION 2. CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL.

The variance for the above-described property is hereby granted a one-time variance from the Ellis County Rules for relief on the 150 feet of public road frontage requirement, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) An application for a simplified plat shall be submitted for review that closely mirrors Exhibit B.

SECTION 3. CONFLICTS.

To the extent of any irreconcilable conflict with the provisions of this Order and other orders of Ellis County governing the use and development of the Property and which are not expressly amended by this Order, the provisions of this Order shall be controlling.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, or word in this order is held invalid or unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this order; and the Commissioners Court hereby declares it would have passed such remaining portions of the Order despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.







SHORT TITLE:

Minimum Front Setback Distance for 5664 Montgomery Road; Parcel ID - 206010.

LEGAL CAPTION:

Consider & act upon a request for 5664 Montgomery Road to grant a one-time variance from Section IV (C)(1) (Building Lines and Easements) of the Subdivision Development Standards to allow one (1) non-habitable structure to encroach onto the minimum front setback distance requirement. The property contains ± 1.95 acres of land located on the south side of Montgomery Road ± 920 feet east of Stonewood Circle in the ETJ of the City of Midlothian, Road & Bridge Precinct No. 4.



APPLICANT(S):

Carmen Blankenship



PURPOSE:

The applicant wishes to construct one (1) 30 feet x 40 feet building to serve as a garage, shop, and storage building. The proposed building would have a covered patio along the south and east sides. Due to the topographic challenges along the eastern front of the lot, a creek that bisects this property along with the applicant's desire to preserve as many trees as possible, a variance is needed to be granted to allow the applicant to construct within the County's minimum setback distance of 25 feet. She is asking for a reduction in the minimum distance to 10 feet from the property line. Per the Subdivision Development Standards, a variance from this requirement is needed before a building permit is granted.



HISTORY:

The final plat of Lots 1R and 2R of Claborn's Forest Addition was approved and filed on June 1998 with the Ellis County Clerk.



OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION:

Section VIII (B) outlines the criteria below for granting relief from the rules and regulations.

1. *That there are special circumstances or conditions affecting the land involved such that the strict application of the provisions of this Order would deprive the applicant of the reasonable use of his land; and,*
2. *That the relief is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of a substantial property right of the applicant; and,*



3. *That the granting of the relief will not be detrimental to the public finances, health, safety or welfare, or injurious to other property in the area; and,*
4. *That the granting of the relief will not have the effect of preventing the orderly subdivision of other land in the area in accordance with the provisions of the Order.*
5. *That the situation causing the hardship or difficulty is neither self-imposed or self-created.*

Section VIII (A) (1) (i) requires notice to be sent to property owners within 200 feet of the property with the requested variance at least fifteen (15) days before the meeting date. Staff sent out six (6) notices via regular mail on March 11, 2019 to satisfy this requirement.



ANALYSIS:

Although the applicant has 1.949 acres of property, the application for a building permit with a structure encroaching into the front building line could not be approved without a variance due to the topography of the land and the applicant's desire to preserve trees as many trees as possible. There is not another suitable location to erect a secondary building on this property without a variance and this request meets the criteria for granting a variance.



RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends **approval** of this variance to Section IV (C) (1) (Lots) of the Subdivision & Development Standards, subject to the following conditions:
1) A building permit application shall be submitted showing a front setback distance of 10 feet for only one (1) non-habitable structure and closely monitored to ensure adherence as set forth in the variance.

SETBACK VARIANCE REQUEST 5664 MONTGOMERY RD. MIDLOTHIAN

I am requesting a variance from Section IV – General Requirements, Subsection C (1) or (2) (Building Lines and Easements) of Volume 1 (Subdivision & Development Standards) of Ellis County Quality Growth and Initiatives for a ten foot front setback line. My property (5664 Montgomery Road) is in an unincorporated area between Midlothian and Ovilla. The area is rural with mix of 10 acre or larger tracts and many tracts between 2 acres and 10 acres. There are also some one acre tracts in the Stonewood Ranch Development which is a gated community that has private drive entrances on two parts of Montgomery Road. Montgomery Road is a narrow, rural, two lane, paved public road. Montgomery Road dead ends into James Wilson on the west end and into Bryson Lane on the east end. Montgomery Road is straight from James Wilson past my property and for probably at least 400 feet beyond my property before it curves to the left. See Exhibit 1 for a picture of the adjacent tracts to mine. See Exhibit 2 for a depiction of Montgomery Road.

VARIANCE CHECKLIST

QUESTION 1: What special circumstances or conditions exist on the property that deprives the applicant of the reasonable use of his land?

This portion of Montgomery Road is quite hilly and rolling. It is also crossed by a number of creeks. This property is essentially a very steep hillside – so steep it is difficult to walk from the back of the house down to the creek or over to the little shed to the west side of the house. There is approximately a 30 foot drop from the front of the property to the back of the property. The back property line is formed by a small creek. There is another larger creek on the property behind mine that joins my creek toward the back east side of my property. The back southeast corner of my property is shown to be in the 100 year flood plane but the entire length of the creek on my back boundary floods when there are heavy rains so I cannot build at the back. On the east side of the house the property also drops dramatically. It is a major drain way for water from Montgomery Road and the front of the property. The house sits below grade with a large rock filled ditch across the entire front of the house to aid in drainage. That ditch dumps the water out on the hill on the east side of the house. The property is heavily wooded and that was a major consideration for me in deciding to purchase this property. When I was shopping for property, I would not look at any property that was not well wooded. It was one of my fundamental criteria. I want to preserve as many trees as possible and not lose any unless absolutely necessary. See Exhibit 3 (Survey of property) and Exhibit 4 (Topographical survey of property).

QUESTION 2 Explain how the relief this regulation is necessary for the preservation of the property.

I wish to build a garage, shop, and storage building that will be 30 feet wide and 40 feet long with a covered a patio shed on two sides (south side and east side of building that is and additional 11 feet wide in the northeast corner of the property.

The only place the property is relatively flat is at the front property line. The further you go back from the front property line, the more dramatically the property slopes and the more trees there are. The front northeast corner of the property was chosen for the location of the building because of its relative flatness, few trees and the ease of walking and driving to the building from the existing circular drive. The north side of the building will be parallel with my front property line and the entrance to the building will face west toward the existing house. The building will be accessed from my existing drive and circular drive with no new entrance on Montgomery Road. Building 25 feet or 40 feet back from the property line creates major construction issues. Many large trees will have to be removed. Further a great deal of fill dirt will have to be brought in which will kill even more trees whose root flares are covered by the soil to make the land level. Fill dirt on a steep hillside does not provide the same stability as the natural ground does. As you can see from the photos (Exhibit 4), water from Montgomery Road and from the front of the property is directed down this hill on the east side of the house by that stone filled ditch that runs across the front of the house. Losing many trees and adding fill dirt is guaranteed to cause major erosion issues on this hill side. I have already addressed the flooding at the back and the steepness of the lot which prevents building behind the house or directly to the east of the house as there is a significant drop off on the east side of the house.

QUESTION 3 Explain how the relief sought will not be detrimental to public finances, health safety or welfare or injurious to other property.

- a. Public finances – no impact. The electric power lines are on the north side of Montgomery Road and the ten foot utility easement is preserved.
- b. Safety – no impact. My front property line is 19-21 feet from the south pavement edge of Montgomery Road. The ten foot setback results in 31 feet of clear space from the south pavement edge of Montgomery Road which runs in a straight line in this area so it will have no impact on traffic or visibility. Those with driveways entering Montgomery Road, have to pull up close to the roadway in the 21 feet between the roadway and the property lines and my proposed building will have no effect on traffic visibility or traffic. Granting this variance will have no effect on police, fire, ambulance, utility or postal service.
- c. Welfare or injury to other property in the area. The proposed building does not increase density in this rural area or crowd any other structure or affect the daylight and air reaching any other structure or affect any one's view from their residence. In fact none of my neighbors will be able to see this building from their residences. It will not affect my neighbors access to or visibility of Montgomery Road. Large metal building and barns are common features in this area. Unlike more dense urban subdivisions with multiple houses on small lots having uniform setbacks, that is not the case in this area. One of the great charms of this area is the absence of uniformity. It will not affect uniformity nor have any environmental impact here versus elsewhere on my property. It will have no impact on traffic, fire, police, ambulance, utility,

Location Map




PURPOSE:

The applicant is requesting the County to release the Maintenance Bond for Bryson Springs, Phase 1. The amount of the maintenance bond is \$364,703, which was 40% of the original performance (construction) bond. The Commissioners' Court approved a final plat for this 36-lot subdivision at its meeting on September 13, 2016. Phase 2 of this subdivision is scheduled for completion in 2020.

The initial issue date for this bond was November 30, 2016, specifically for streets, roads, and drainage requirements and should have expired two (2) years later, however, due to the heavy rainfall the area experienced in the fall, the developer was not able to complete all the necessary work until recently.



ANALYSIS:

The County has inspected all roads and infrastructure within this subdivision and determined to be "substantially complete" meeting all regulations and requirements set forth by the County.

2. **ACCEPTANCE** The terms and conditions set forth on the front and reverse side of the Agreement is an offer to purchase Service by Customer which shall become a Service Agreement when acknowledged in writing by Crosspoint Communications, and the banking, negotiation or other use of any payment shall not constitute an acceptance by Crosspoint Communications. It is agreed that Service shall be provided only on the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement. Crosspoint Communications shall not be bound by terms and conditions in Customer's purchase order or elsewhere unless expressly agreed to in writing.
3. **SERVICE DENIED**
4. Crosspoint Communications agrees to provide service for the Customer for the Product listed on the front side of this Agreement. Such Products shall be serviced according to the terms and conditions on the front and reverse side of the Agreement ("Service"). The Services shall begin and end on the dates set forth on the front side of the Agreement. Crosspoint Communications shall also Service other Product manufactured by Motorola and purchased by customer during the term of the Agreement at the then current service fees for such Product. Upon delivery of such Product to Customer, service fees for Service for such other Product shall be added to the billing cycle following expiration of the labor warranty on such other Product. In the event of loss, damage, theft or removal from Service of any Product, Customer shall immediately report the loss, damage, theft or removal in writing to Crosspoint Communications. In this event, customer's obligation to pay service fees with respect of any such Product shall terminate at the end of the month in which Crosspoint Communications received such written report.
5. Mobile Product shall be removed and reinstalled in different vehicles at Customer's request for the service fee in effect at the time of Customer's request.
6. This Agreement does not include service of any transmission line, antenna, or tower lighting, unless such work is described on the front side of this Agreement. Service shall include the labor and parts required to repair Product which has become defective through normal wear and usage. This does not include consumables and their installation. Service does not include repair or replacement of Product which has otherwise become defective, including, but not limited to, damage caused by accidents, physical or electronic abuse or misuse, acts of God, fires or other casualty. Service performed for non covered repairs shall be billed at Crosspoint Communications above contract rate applicable for such Service. Products under contract must be maintained in environment conditions as set forth in the Product specifications and damage resulting from environmental conditions not conforming to the specifications is not covered by the Agreement.
7. Where telephone lines and Product are used in conjunction with Crosspoint Communications maintained Product, Crosspoint Communications shall have no obligation or responsibility for such telephone lines or Product but shall, upon request, assist the Telephone Company in repairing such upon payment as the appropriate above contract rate.
8. Customer shall indicate on the front side of this Agreement any Product which is intrinsically safe so that appropriate parts and procedures may be used to maintain such status.
9. At the expiration of twelve (12) months after the commencement of the Service hereunder (or any time thereafter), if Product cannot in Crosspoint Communications opinion be properly or economically repaired, because (but not limited to) excessive wear, deterioration or unavailability of parts, Crosspoint Communication as its sole option, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Customer sent by certified mail, may either: (1) remove such Product from this Agreement; or (2) may increase the price to Service such Product. Customer has thirty (30) days from receipt of notice of price increase to object to such increase. If Customer properly objects to such increase, Crosspoint Communications shall then have the option to remove such Product from coverage by this Agreement. Customer's obligation to pay Service fees with respect to the Product removed from this Agreement shall terminate at the end of the month during which such Product is removed.
10. For a period of twelve months from the delivery of the services under this Agreement, the Customer shall not directly or indirectly, contract or hire Crosspoint Communications personnel performing the services under this Agreement unless with written consent of Crosspoint Communications. If the customer violates the provisions of this section (10), then the customer agrees to pay the sum of \$75,000.00 per incident as liquid damages.
11. **SERVICE STANDARDS** the Product shall be serviced by Crosspoint Communications in accordance with the following standards: (i) Motorola parts or parts of equal quality shall be used; (ii) the Product shall be serviced at levels set forth in Motorola's product manuals; and (iii) routine service procedures prescribed from time to time by Motorola for its Product shall be followed.
12. **TIME AND PLACE OF SERVICE**
13. Service shall be done at the location specified on the front side of the Agreement. Where Service is to be performed as the location of the Product, customer shall furnish shelter, heat, light and power to these locations. Customer shall notify Crosspoint Communications immediately of Product failure, allow Crosspoint Communications full and free access to the Product and cooperate fully with Crosspoint Communications servicing the Product. Waiver of liability by Crosspoint Communications against the Customer or other restrictions shall not be imposed by Customer as a site access requirement. Customer shall allow Crosspoint Communications full and free access to the Product. Customer shall allow Crosspoint Communications to use necessary communications, machines, facilities, features and other product (except as normally supplied by Crosspoint Communications) at no charge. Mobiles and removable Product shall be delivered by Customer to the Crosspoint Communications Service Center indicated on the front side of the Agreement.
14. **PAYMENT/ TAXES** On or about the date each payment is due as set forth on the front side of this Agreement. Crosspoint Communications shall send Customer an invoice covering the Service fees for the next Payment Period. All other charges shall be billed monthly, and the Customer shall pay the amount of each invoice within ten (10) days of its date to the Crosspoint Communications office designated by Crosspoint Communications. Each invoice shall be due and payable whether or not the Product is operation, and Crosspoint Communications may terminate this Agreement by giving the Customer ten (10) days notice by certified mail if the Customer defaults in its payment to Crosspoint Communications. Customer shall reimburse Crosspoint Communications for all property taxes, sales and use taxes, excise taxes and other taxes or assessments now or hereafter imposed by authority of any

Federal, State or Local law, rule or regulation to the Service of the Product except Federal Income and profit taxes of Crosspoint Communications and State income and franchise taxes of Crosspoint Communications.

15. **RIGHT TO SUBCONTRACT** Crosspoint Communications shall have the right to subcontract in whole or in parts the Service called for by this Agreement. Crosspoint Communications shall notify Customer of the name and address of each subcontractor.
16. **REVISION OF FEES** Prior to the anniversary of the "Expiration Date" indicated on the front side of this Agreement, Crosspoint Communications may revise the Service fees set forth on the front side of this Agreement by giving Customer written notice of the amount of the increase at least sixty (60) days in advance of that Anniversary Date. Upon receipt of any such notice, Customer may terminate this Agreement on the Expiration Date or any Anniversary of it upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Crosspoint Communications sent by certified mail to the address indicated on this Agreement; otherwise the new fees shall become effective on the Anniversary date. In the event such termination, all accrued and unpaid charges shall be due and payable immediately upon termination.
17. **AUTOMATIC RENEWAL** After the expiration date indicated on the front side of this Agreement, the Agreement shall continue for successive additional periods of one year, provided that either Crosspoint Communications or Customer may terminate this Agreement on the expiration date or any Anniversary of it upon thirty (30) days prior written to the other party sent by certified mail to the address indicated on the Agreement.
18. **INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE** Customer shall notify Crosspoint Communications in the event of failure of any Product. If Crosspoint Communications fails to repair the Product, within a reasonable time, Customer shall notify Crosspoint communications office. After said notice from Customer to Crosspoint communications, Crosspoint Communications shall be available for any interruption of interference affecting the use of transmission through the Product maintained to the extent of a pro rate allowance based on the monthly service fee for the time such interruption or interference is attributable to the fault of Crosspoint Communications or its subcontractor to. Crosspoint Communications does not assume and shall have no liability under this Agreement for failure to provide or delay in providing service for the Product due directly or indirectly to causes beyond the control of Crosspoint Communications, including, but not restricted to, acts of God, acts public enemy acts of the United States, any State, Territory of the United States, or any political subdivision of the foregoing, or the District of Columbia, acts of failure to act of the Customer, its agents, employees or subcontractors, fires, floods, casualty, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes and unusually severe weather conditions or defaults of Crosspoint Communications subcontractors due to any such causes.
19. **WARRANTY LIMITATIONS EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN THIS AGREEMENT, CROSSPOINT COMMUNICATIONS DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATIONS, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. IN NO EVENT SHALL CROSSPOINT COMMUNICATIONS BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTALS OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO THE FULL EXTENT SUCH MAY BE DISCLAIMED BY LAW.**
20. **FCC AND OTHER GOVERNMENT MATTERS** Although Crosspoint Communications may assist in the preparation of the FCC license application, Customer is solely responsible for obtaining any licenses or other authorizations required by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") or any other Federal, State or Local government agency. Customer is solely responsible for complying with applicable FCC rules and regulations and the applicable rules and regulations of any other Federal, State or Local government agency. Neither Crosspoint Communications nor any of its employees is an agent of Customer in FCC or other governmental matters. Crosspoint Communications however may assist in preparation of the FCC license application at no charge to Customer.
21. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT** Customer acknowledges that it has read and understands the terms and conditions of the Agreement and agrees to be bound by them, that it is complete and conclusive statement of the agreement between the parties, and that this Agreement sets forth the entire agreement and understanding between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof and all understandings and agreements oral and written, heretofore make between Crosspoint Communications and Customer, are merged in the Agreement which alone fully and completely expresses their agreement.
22. **AMENDMENT** No Modification of or additions to the Agreement shall be binding upon Crosspoint Communications unless such modification is in writing and signed by the Crosspoint Communications Division Service Vice President authorized to make such revisions and an agent of Customer.

24. **HEADINGS** Section and paragraph headings used in this Agreement are for the convenience only and are not to be deemed or construed to be part of this Agreement.
25. **LAW THIS AGREEMENT AND THE RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THE PARTIES SHALL BE GOVERNED AND INTERPRETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.**
26. **ASSIGNMENT** No assignment or transfer, in whole or in part, of this Agreement by Customer shall be binding upon Crosspoint Communications without its prior written consent.
27. **WAIVER** Failure or delay on the part of Crosspoint Communications or Customer to exercise any right, power or privilege under this Agreement shall not operate as a waiver of any right, power or privilege of this Agreement.
28. **The Non Solicitation Agreement attached is part of the Agreement if executed by both parties.**



The Operator conducted multiple “in-house” surveys this permit year to ensure County operations are using BMPs as often and effectively as possible. These surveys included the County Commissioners, Road and Bridge staff, County Engineer and Assistant County Engineer. During previous permit years, stormwater staff has primarily focused on education and outreach MCMs for reducing the discharge of pollutants to the MEP.

Also, the implementation of the Ellis County Drainage Design Manual has been another major addition to our progress this year. We have added more restrictive storm water requirements for new subdivision construction. This mostly pertains to subdivision design in regards to pre and post development. In addition to the drainage design manual, we implemented a preliminary grading process to ensure we obtain a SWPPP, erosion control plan, and NOI before any grade work is completed for a subdivision.





WHEREAS, The year 1999 marks the 150th anniversary of the founding of Ellis County, and it is indeed a privilege to recognize this momentous occasion, and to pay tribute to the citizens of this exceptional Texas county; and

WHEREAS, Named for Richard Ellis, the president of the Convention of 1836, which declared Texas' independence from Mexico, Ellis County occupies more than 950 square miles of North Central Texas; gently rolling terrain and level plains make up the area's landscape, which is bounded on the east by the rich soils of the Blackland Belt; and

WHEREAS, In 1850, Waxahachie was chosen as the county seat, and soon thereafter the inaugural Ellis County Court authorized the construction of the county's first courthouse; a new structure of red sandstone and granite was constructed in 1895, and that venerable edifice continues to serve the county's citizens and is recognized as one of the Lone Star State's most magnificent landmarks; and

WHEREAS, While Ellis County remains one of the leading agricultural counties in the state, the city of Midlothian has a thriving industrial area and is home to several major companies, including Chaparral Steel Company, Texas Industries, Holnam Texas, and North Texas Cement Company; and

WHEREAS, Education is important to the citizens of Ellis County, and Milford is the site of the county's first school, which was established by Michael Dickson nearly 150 years ago; today, Navarro College and Southwestern Assemblies of God University stand at the forefront of the county's commitment to educational excellence; and


