

**PUBLIC INPUT SOUGHT
FOR PROPOSED
REHABILITATION OF FLOODWATER RETARDING STRUCTURES NO. 4 AND 6
OF THE CHAMBERS CREEK WATERSHED,
MIDLOTHIAN, TEXAS**

The Ellis County, Ellis-Prairie Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), local sponsors of the Chambers Creek Watershed, and the United States Department of Agriculture-Natural Resources Conservation Service (USDA-NRCS) are beginning the planning process to develop a Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment for the rehabilitation needs of Floodwater Retarding Structure No. 4 and 6. Site No. 4 is located north of FM 1387 and east of Midlothian Parkway. Site No. 6 is located South of Plainview Road and north of Mt Zion Road.

This project is part of the Small Watershed Rehabilitation Amendments of 2000 (Section 313, PL 106-472). This legislation authorized the USDA-NRCS to work with local community leaders and watershed sponsors to rehabilitate aging watershed dams built under Public Law 78-534, Public Law 83-566, and the Pilot Watershed programs.
