**A Resolution by the Ellis County Commissioners' Court  
Declaring Severe Weather Awareness Week in Ellis County, Texas**

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service has declared March 3<sup>rd</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> to be Severe Weather Awareness Week to promote public information regarding severe weather precautions; and

**WHEREAS**, on Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>, Ellis County Emergency Management is partnering with the National Weather Service to host a free SKYWARN storm spotter training session, an opportunity for all to learn what they can do to help their community prepare for severe weather events; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the interest of public safety that the Commissioners' Court of Ellis County desires to promote public awareness, education, and training that will prepare our citizens for severe weather events; and

**WHEREAS**, by participating in Severe Weather Awareness Week, Ellis County will benefit from a synchronized effort by local, state, federal, and non-governmental agencies to increase public awareness of the potential dangers of severe weather, as well as to distribute educational material informing citizens of the steps they can take to prepare for, remain safe within, and recover from severe weather incidents;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the commissioners of Ellis County, Texas, hereby declare March 3<sup>rd</sup> – March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2025 to be Severe Weather Awareness Week in Ellis County, and that we endorse and support all efforts by Ellis County Emergency Management to promote public awareness and education of severe weather through partnership and coordination with the National Weather Service and all other participating organizations.
