**A Resolution by the Ellis County Commissioners' Court
To Join Public Power Pool in Support of a Power Supply Agreement**

WHEREAS, Public Power Pool (dba "P3") is a member of the Texas CUC Aggregation Project and is a political subdivision corporation created in accordance with Chapter 304 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of P3 is to aggregate electricity demand of all member political subdivisions in order to obtain electricity rates that are lower than any individual political subdivision would be able to obtain by itself; and

WHEREAS, by aggregating demand for electricity in North Texas, P3 reduces the financial burden of power supply passed on to citizens through local tax rates; and

WHEREAS, by streamlining the power supply agreement process through P3, Ellis County is contributing to the overall efficiency of the Texas electric grid, thus helping to elevate the strategic position of the United States as a leader in energy production; and

WHEREAS, on March 21st, 2025, P3 provided a "Notice of Intent to Begin a Competitive Procurement Process" for electricity for P3 members for a term beginning January 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Commissioners of Ellis County, Texas:

- 1) Hereby agree to join as a member entity of Public Power Pool (P3); and
- 2) Direct P3 to solicit competitive pricing for electricity generated by renewable sources from retail electric providers that agree to P3's contracting terms and conditions; and
- 3) Direct that P3 execute a final power supply agreement for a term beginning in January, 2026 for a term not to exceed 10 years at a rate(s) at or below 110% of the ceiling rates identified in the Procurement Ceiling and Expected Rate Estimate provided by P3.




