On this the 19th day of September, 2023, the County Commissioners Court of Ellis County, Texas, convened in a Special Session of said Court, at 101 West Main Street, Waxahachie, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

And among other proceedings, on motion of Commissioner Lane Grayson, seconded by Commissioner Paul Perry, duly put and carried the following Order was passed:

WHEREAS, this order is authorized and in accordance with section §352.081 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions no longer exist in all of Ellis County, Texas; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF ELLIS COUNTY, TEXAS, that:

Effective immediately, the ban on all burning of any materials including trash, waste or any other outdoor fire, enacted on **July 25th, 2023**, minute order 361.23, has been withdrawn.







Precinct #1




Commissioner Lane Grayson
