ORDER RESETTING BOND

The Defendant has been charged with the offense of _____. The current bond is set at _____. After considering the agreement of the parties and/or the evidence and argument presented to the Court by the parties, the Defendant’s bond is hereby ordered to be reset to _____. As conditions of bond, the Defendant must reappear for all court settings, not consume illegal drugs/narcotics, not be involved in criminal activity, and keep Defendant’s attorney advised of all current contact information. The Defendant must also abide by the following conditions while on bond for this cause:

- Abstain from the consumption of alcohol and alcoholic beverages.
- Not threaten, harass, or assault any person, including _____.
- Not go within 100 yards of _____.
- Abide by a curfew of _____.
- Submit to weekly/bi-weekly/monthly scheduled drug testing and random drug testing at the direction of the Ellis County Adult Community Supervision Department and pay a \$50 per month supervision and testing fee.
- Have installed on the motor vehicle owned by the defendant or on the vehicle most regularly driven by the defendant, a device that uses a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism equipped with photo or video verification to make impractical the operation of a motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator and not operate any motor vehicle unless the vehicle is equipped with that device. Defendant shall abstain from the consumption of alcohol and alcoholic beverages.

Failure to abide by the conditions of bond and/or release, may result in the increase of bond, the revocation of bond, additional conditions of bond, and/or the arrest of the Defendant.
