

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF REVISED COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS FOR ELLIS COUNTY, TEXAS

On April 15, 2025, in open court the Commissioners of Ellis County adopted revised county election precincts to comply with Texas Election Code chapter 42. A brief description of the changes to election precincts is included as required by Texas Election Code section 42.035. The new precinct lines and numbers will become effective on January 1, 2026 (Section 42.033 of the Texas Election Code). New voter certificates will be mailed to each active registered voter by January 12, 2026.

Below is a brief explanation of the adopted precinct boundary changes to two Ellis County Election Precincts

2022 Election Precinct (Old)	2026 Election Precinct (New)	Brief Description and Reason for Change
1006	Stays 1006	Due to population of voters; Split original precinct along Highway 77 (East portion) to keep as original pct number 1006.
1006	1060	Split original precinct along Highway 77 (West portion) Re-numbered to create NEW precinct 1060 pct
1038	Stays 1038	Due to population of voters; Split original precinct along South 14 th Street (West portion) to keep as original pct number 1038
1038	1061	Split original precinct along South 14 th Street (East portion) Re-numbered to create NEW precinct 1061
