INFORMATION SHEET**

See Chapter 53 for the numerous requirements for compressed gas systems.

No person shall perform or authorize Construction or Substantial Improvement within the unincorporated areas of Ellis County without first securing a permit.

A permit is not required for maintenance.

For emergency repair work performed on an emergency basis, application for a permit shall be made within two working days of commencement of work.

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A permit fee in accordance with the Ellis County Fire Code.
2. A set of documentation sufficient to establish that the installation meets all of the requirements of Chapter 53
