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Construction Permit INFORMATION SHEET

Exceptions:

1. Routine maintenance
2. For repair work performed on an emergency basis, application for permit must be made within two working days of commencement of work

No one may perform or authorize Construction or Substantial Improvement within the unincorporated areas of Ellis County without first securing a permit.

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A completed Construction Permit Application.
2. A permit fee in accordance with the Ellis County Fire Code.
3. Site plan showing where hazardous materials in excess of the MAQ are stored, property lines, fire apparatus access roads
4. Additional documentation as required by the fire code official.

All construction and demolition activities must be performed in accordance with Chapter 33.
