Operational Permit INFORMATION SHEET

An Operational permit is required for the manufacture, storage, handling, sale or use of any quantity of *explosives, explosive materials, fireworks or pyrotechnic special effects* within the scope of Chapter 56. **EXCEPTION:** Storage in Group R-3 occupancies for personal use and not for resale.

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A completed Operational Permit Application.
2. A floor plan for each building/magazine that includes:
 - a) The location of all exits, the distance between exits, and the exit dimensions.
 - b) The location of any fire alarm equipment, automatic sprinklers, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, fire alarm control panel, EXIT signs and smoke detectors required to meet the Fire Code.
3. A site plan indicating the location of the building/magazine on the property and the location of any fire hydrants, fire lanes/fire access roads and parking areas. The plan shall show the distance from the magazine to the nearest public highway, distance from magazine to magazine and the distance from the magazine to the nearest inhabited building.
4. An inventory for each magazine indicating the quantity, in pounds, of explosive materials stored within.
5. A permit fee in accordance with Section 8.3, Table I of the Ellis County Fire Code.
6. Proof of financial responsibility

At the time of inspection, be prepared to show documentation that you are in compliance with Section 5605.2 of the 2018 edition of the International Fire Code.
