Operational Permit
INFORMATION SHEET

An Operational permit is required for mobile food preparation vehicles equipped with appliances that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors. See Section 319 for additional details.

An operational permit allows the applicant to conduct an operation or a business for which a permit is required by section 105.6 for either:

- a. A specified period
- b. Until renewed or revoked

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A completed Operational Permit Application.
2. A permit fee in accordance with the Ellis County Fire Code.
3. A photograph of the vehicle to be permitted.
4. Copy of a fuel gas system inspection of the LP-gas system performed in the past 12 months. A legible photograph of the inspection tag is satisfactory.
5. Copy of the fuel gas inspection of the CNG system completed in the past 36 months. A photo of the inspection tag is satisfactory.
6. Copy of the most recent exhaust system inspection and cleaning. A photo of the inspection tag is satisfactory.

SECTION 319 - MOBILE FOOD PREPARATION VEHICLES

319.3 Exhaust hood. Cooking equipment that produces grease-laden vapors shall be provided with a kitchen exhaust hood in accordance with Section 607.

SECTION 607- COMMERCIAL KITCHEN HOODS

607.1 General. Commercial kitchen exhaust hoods shall comply with the requirements of the *International Mechanical Code*.

607.2 Where required. A Type I hood shall be installed at or above all commercial cooking appliances and domestic cooking appliances used for commercial purposes that produce grease vapors.

319.4.1 Fire protection for cooking equipment. Cooking equipment shall be protected by automatic fire extinguishing systems in accordance with Section 904.12.

904.12 Commercial cooking systems. The automatic fire extinguishing system for commercial cooking systems shall be of a type recognized for protection of commercial cooking equipment and exhaust systems of the type and arrangement protected. Pre-engineered automatic dry- and wet-chemical extinguishing systems shall be tested in accordance with UL 300 and *listed* and *labeled* for the intended application. Other types of automatic fire-extinguishing systems shall be *listed* and *labeled* for specific use as protection for commercial cooking operations. The system shall be installed in accordance with this code, NFPA 96, its listing and the manufacturer's installation instructions. Automatic fire-extinguishing systems of the following types shall be installed in accordance NFPA.
