**Operational Permit INFORMATION SHEET**

An Operational permit is required to conduct a spraying or dipping operation utilizing flammable or combustible liquids or the application of combustible powders regulated by Chapter 24.

An operational permit allows the applicant to conduct an operation or a business for which a permit is required by section 105.6 for either:

- a. A specified period
- b. Until renewed or revoked

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

- 1. A completed Operational Permit Application.
- 2. A floor plan for the affected building that includes:
  - a) The location of all exits, the distance between exits, and the exit dimensions.
  - b) The location of any fire alarm equipment, automatic sprinklers, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, fire alarm control panel, and EXIT signs.
- 3. A site plan indicating the location of the building on the property and the location of any fire hydrants, fire lanes/fire access roads and parking areas.
- 4. A permit fee in accordance with Section 8.3, Table I of the Ellis County Fire Code.

The Ellis County Fire Code consists of the 2018 International Fire Code and all its references, and the Recommended Amendments to the 2018 International Fire Code by the North Central Texas Council of Governments. If you have any questions, please contact our office at 972-825-5555.
