Operational Permit INFORMATION SHEET

An Operational permit is required for the operation of wrecking yards, junk yards, and waste material handling facilities.

An operational permit allows the applicant to conduct an operation or a business for which a permit is required by section 105.6 for either:

- a. A specified period
- b. Until renewed or revoked

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A completed Operational Permit Application.
2. A site plan indicating the location of the buildings and storage areas on the property and the distance from the lot lines, the location of overhead power lines, the location of any fire hydrants, fire lanes/fire access roads and parking areas.
3. A permit fee of \$100.00
